What we do

How does PATRIOT BANK, N.A. protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include secure computer systems, access controls, monitoring, encryption where appropriate, and secure facilities and records management.

How does PATRIOT BANK, N.A. collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- Open an account or apply for a loan
- Deposit money or use your credit or debit card
- Pay your bills

We may also collect your personal information from credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies, as permitted by law.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives consumers to limit only

- Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes related to creditworthiness;
- Affiliates using your information to market to you; and
- Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws may provide additional privacy rights.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They may be financial and non-financial companies.

- *PATRIOT BANK, N.A. does not share information with affiliates as described in this notice.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They may be financial and non-financial companies.

- *PATRIOT BANK, N.A. does not share information with our non-affiliate companies so they can market to you.*

Joint Marketing

A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that jointly market financial products or services to you.

- *PATRIOT BANK, N.A. does not engage in joint marketing with other financial companies.*
