This Cookie Policy applies to any pages within the BankPatriot.com domain.

By using the Patriot Bank site, you are consenting to our use of cookies in accordance with this Cookie Policy. If you do not agree to our use of cookies in this way, you should set your browser settings accordingly or not use the Patriot Bank site. If you disable the cookies that we use, this may impact your user experience while on the Patriot Bank site.

The table on page 2 summarizes the different types of cookie we use on Patriot Bank sites, together with their respective purpose and duration (i.e. how long each cookie will remain on your device).

What are cookies?

Cookies are files or pieces of information that may be stored on your computer (or other internet enabled devices, such as a smartphone or tablet) when you visit the Patriot Bank website. A cookie will usually contain the name of the website from which the cookie has come from, the "lifetime" of the cookie (i.e. how long it will remain on your device), and a value, which is usually a randomly generated unique number.

What do we use cookies for?

We use cookies to make the Patriot Bank website easier to use and to better tailor the Patriot Bank site and our products to your interests and needs. Cookies may also be used to help speed up your future activities and experience on our Sites. We also use cookies to compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how people use our site and to help us improve the structure and content. We cannot identify you personally from this information.

What types of cookies do we use?

Two types of cookies may be used on the Patriot Bank Sites – "session cookies" and "persistent cookies". Session cookies are temporary cookies that remain on your device until you leave the site. A persistent cookie remains on your device for much longer or until you manually delete it (how long the cookie remains on your device will depend on the duration or "lifetime" of the specific cookie and your browser settings).

Type of Cookie	Who is it owned by	What do they do?	Do these cookies collect my personal data/identify me?
Persistent	Google Analytics	These web analytics cookies, provided by Google Inc., are used to collect information about how visitors use our site. We use the information to compile reports and to help us improve the site.	The cookies collect information in an anonymous form, including the number of visitors to the site, where visitors have come to the site from and the pages they visited.
Persistent	JavaScript	Checks for the presence of "alerted" cookie – meaning the user of the browser has already seen the website pop-up alert.	The cookies only collect information from the browser used. No personal information is collected.
Persistent	JavaScript	Keeps record of username and password for login.	The cookies only collect information from the browser used. No personal information is collected.
Session	JavaScript	These cookies check to see if the user has JavaScript enabled. JavaScript is a requirement for displaying the site correctly.	The cookies only collect information from the browser used. No personal information is collected.
Session	Digital Insight	These cookies are an integral part of the Internet Banking/Mobile Banking login process.	This cookie collects some personal information and directs the user to the proper location in the Digital Insight site after they login.

How can I control or delete cookies?

Most internet browsers are initially set up to automatically accept cookies. You can change the settings to block cookies or to alert you when cookies are being sent to your device. There are a number of ways to manage cookies. Please refer to your browser instructions or help screen to learn more about how to adjust or modify your browser settings.
